"Jesu, Jesu" was written by Thomas S. Colvin (1925-2000). Colvin was a pastoral missionary for the Church of Scotland and was an active member of the ecumenical

**NOTE** Iona Community for nearly 50 years. Many of his songs use African melodies. He nurtured new African congregational songs by adapting local melodies and writing new texts appropriate for African Christians. The melody of "Jesu, Jesu" is adapted from a Ghanaian folk song he heard during his years of service there. The song stresses loving our neighbor, and in a way, the song itself is a great example of collaboration between two cultures - the text from a European Christian inspired by his service in Ghana and the melody from West African people.

"You shall not hate any of your kindred in your heart. Reprove your neighbor openly so that you do not incur sin because of that person. Take no revenge and cherish no grudge against your own people. You shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD." ~ Leviticus 19:17-18
