

Susan Burchfield, M.S., L.P.C.C. is a licensed professional counselor who has a master's degree in Pre-Clinical Psychology. She has been in private practice for over 30 years, working with families and individuals. Susan is discussing "Healthy Coping Skills" with our high school students for their "Blessed Not Stressed—Positive Addiction Day at DSJ" on April 20th. On April 23rd, Susan has agreed to have a presentation for any adults who may be interested in learning more about students and their emotional/mental well-being. Her presentation will take place from 6:30 p.m. -8:30 p.m. in the All Saints Gym. The parental presentation will focus on attempting to understand the teenage brain and how it affects their emotional state.
