LYNN'S MUSIC NOTES

The next several weeks, I'll be addressing the revised rite of marriage which is called The Order of Celebrating Matrimony. You probably have or will attend a wedding soon, or maybe you are planning one and wondered why the entrance procession is different. The revised rite really stresses that this is a liturgical event right from the start with priest, servers and wedding party including the bride and groom with parents all entering together. There's also an opening hymn now that calls us all to participate. It's a challenge, especially at a wedding to participate sometimes, but the new rite is very similar to a Sunday Mass including a liturgical entrance procession, singing the Gloria and reciting the Creed. Our active participation is needed to express our support and joy for the couple entering holy matrimony.
