Delphos St. John's High School SADD Team will hold a mock crash to raise student awareness about the risks students could encounter during prom and graduation season and the associated tragedy of vehicular crashes. **The mock crash will be held on Thursday, May 2nd at 1:00 p.m. at Delphos St. John's High School – 515 East Second Street, Delphos.** The goal of this program is to educate students about the consequences of teen drinking, texting and driving crashes. Fire, EMS, law enforcement, and medical personnel will recreate a traffic crash, with as much realism as possible – using students as victims. The mock crash concept helps students visualize what a crash is really like: car crashes are dirty, bloody, noisy, painful, frightening, personal and the impact of a crash can continue for their lifetime – changing their life trajectory. SADD Advisor Kelly Hershey stated, "It is our hope the students have a safe and memorable prom and graduation season. We hope they make good decisions so they can avoid any accidents or injuries that could change their lives forever." Community agencies supporting the mock crash presentation include, Chief Mark Slate and the City of Delphos Police Department, Chief Kevin Streets and the Delphos Fire and Rescue Department, Morgan Shobe, Jenny Snider and Brenda Snyder (volunteer) with Mercy Health – St. Rita's Medical Center, Eric Schier and Harter and Schier Funeral Home, Brian Anderson and Life Flight, Sheeter's County Line Auto Wrecking, Todd and Jaime Elwer and the Allen County Prosecutor's Office.

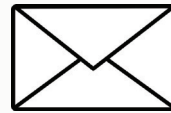

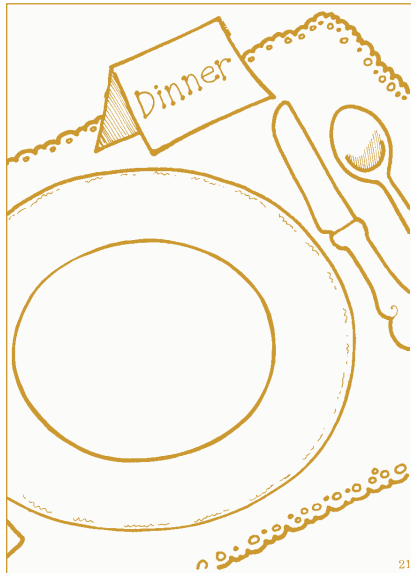

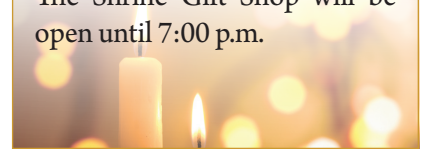


**RUCALLED DINNER**
